SUBMISSIONS AND PUBLICATION

We invite contributions in the form of papers and tutorial related to WER's workshop. Papers may be in English, Portuguese or Spanish but English is preferred. During the event, participants must present their work in English. Long papers should not exceed 14 pages in **Springer-Verlag's LNCS format**

(<http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html>). Submissions should be sent via the EasyChair submission system.

Items will be evaluated according to their relevance, originality, technical quality and their relevance to conference topics. Papers will be published by the organization in a book with ISBN number. Additionally, papers will be indexed by DBLP and made available in WER series repository (<http://wer.inf.puc-rio.br/WERpapers/>).

Submissions should be sent via the EasyChair submission system (<http://www.easychair.org/conferences/?conf=wer12>). They will be reviewed according to their relevance, originality, technical quality, and adequacy to the conference topics.
